The Great Pumpkin Race Directions and Regulations

- 1. Design and construct your pumpkin race car from a single real pumpkin in any shape and size.
- 2. Pumpkin Race Cars can be whole or carved; outrageously decorated or just like it came from the pumpkin patch.
- 3. Insert two independent axels through your pumpkin and attach any type or size wheels to the axels.
- 4. You cannot attach your pumpkin to anything that creates a chassis of any kind such as skateboards, wagons, toys, strollers.... You get the picture.
- 5. Your pumpkin must be powered by the gravity from the downhill slope of the race track; no fans, motors, explosives, pyrotechnics or PUSHING.
- 6. Pumpkins will race side-by-side, there is no penalty if pumpkins bump or collide with other pumpkins, the race track walls or anything else.
- 7. Pumpkins will be inspected at check in and any race cars not built to race regulations could be placed in the "MOD" (Made Own Directions) Division.
- 8. Race Divisions may be created at check-in based on the total number of participants and race official's discretion.
- 9. Special prizes for race winners plus prizes for creativity, decorations and much more.
- 10. Have fun making your Pumpkin Race Cars, be creative and let your imagination run wild. If you don't win you'll at least be racing in style.

Important Rules

- 1. The Race Officials will have the final say if your pumpkin is eligible to race and determines all winners and everything else. More importantly the Race Officials can change or alter the rules at any time.
- 2. If there is any doubt about eligibility or winner or anything please refer to rule 1.
