

As of March 1st 2016 Ocean City passed a new trailer ordinance:

- From May 1st to October 31st trailers and oversized vehicle parking are banned on all public streets.
- During Cruisin Ocean City & Endless Summer Cruisin trailer parking will be allowed on public streets (other than Baltimore Ave) with an event Trailer Parking Permit.
- Trailer Parking Permits can be purchased during the event for registered participants only. The permit fee is \$50, and can be paid by cash or a check payable to “The Town of Ocean City”. Trailer permits can be picked up starting Wednesday morning of the event at the Convention Center.
- As before, free trailer parking for registered participants will still be available at the Rt. 50 Park & Ride. This continues to be on a first come first serve basis & at your own risk.
- Trailers can still be parked on private property. Be sure to check with your OC accommodations to see if they provide trailer parking. Many hotels offer trailer parking as well.
